recorded by Miss Barbara Fairweather and
D.C. Cargill May 1969.

1. Mary McMillan who d. at North Ballachulish on 1 Dec. 1841 aged 45 yrs. erected by her son Donald Turner 1854.
2. (1842) by the Rev. John McMillan M.A. of the Episcopal Church in memory of his father Duncan McMillan who died at Laroch 5 Feb. 1832 aged 74 yrs. and of his mother Ann McKensie who died 10 Dec. 1832 aged 71 yrs.
3. Alexander McMillan d. at Slate Quarry, Ballachulish 26 Jul. 1805 aged 75 yrs. and his spouse Ann Buchannan. By Duncan McMillan their son.
4. Christina McIntyre spouse of Angus Cameron tenant of the Ferry of Ballachulish in Argyle died on the 24 Jan. 1837 in the 37th year of her age also said Angus Cameron d. at Inohree 4 Dec. 1862 aged 75 yrs. 11 mths.

11. Duncan McPherson who d. 31 Jan. 1845 aged 43 yrs. erected by Mary Stewart his wife their sons Duncan, Dugald, James the latter d. at Greenock on his passage to Australia Feb. 1845.
12. John Rankin, Weaver 1856.
13. In the memory of Alexander Rankin, Tighfurst d. 16 Dec. 1852 aged 74 yrs. also four of his family which d. in their inf. Mary Livingstone his widow, by the concurrence of their sons caused this stone to be erected and desires when her days are fulfilled her remains to be laid in the same grave.

15. Angus McDonald late Tacksman of Inverighan who died Aug. 1815 aged 82 yrs. and of Mary Rankin - By order of their son Allan McDonald.
16. Alexander McDonald late at Carnooh who d. 8 Mar. 1812 37 yrs. C.M.D. Erected by Colin McDonald, Larooh.
17. By Rachel McLean in memory of her husband, Angus MacDonald Uist, who d. 22 May 1853 aged 53 yrs.
18. By Alex McColl at Carnooh and his spouse Jean Kennedy to memory of their daughter Catharine who d. 19 Mar. 1822 aged 10 months.
19. Two infant children, descendants of Peter Henderson, carpenter at Larooh, and Sarah Cameron his wife. Placed here by Peter Henderson a native of Berwickshire. A.D. 1830.
20. William White, a native of Lanarkshire who d. at Larooh on the 9 Jan. 1827 in the 89th yr. of his age, a gardener by trade. For 17 yrs. a private soldier in the 73rd. regt, of foot, in which he fought in the East Indies during the wars of Hyder Ali. For 14 yrs. gardener at Ballachulish. A good gardener, a brave soldier, honest and remarkably intelligent man. To commemorate his good qualities this stone is placed here by Charles Stuart Esq., of Ballachulish 1831.
21. Archd. McIntyre who d. 9 May 1839 aged 6 yrs. also Donald McIntyre who died 1 Feb. 1842 aged 20 yrs. Erected by their brother Alexr. McIntyre, Carnooh Glencoe. Also John McIntyre d. 16 Jul. 1842 aged 14 yrs.
22. Mary McIntyre dau. of Dugd. McIntyre, Carnooh who d. Aug. 1840 aged 16 yrs. Erected by her uncle John McIntyre.
23. Sergt. John McIntyre, 52nd Regt. who died at Glencoe Swpt. 1843 aged 60 yrs.
24. Sarah Cameron who d. on the 3rd day of the 1st month in the year 1819 aged 38 yrs. This stone is placed by her husband Ian McColl, slater in Ballachulish. 1831.
25. Donald Cameron, Joiner, Cuilchena who d. Mar. 1822 aged 70 yrs. and his sons Duncan d. Oct. 1811 aged 27. John d. Apr. 1838 aged 66, buried in Edinburgh and who's widow erects this tablet. Donald d. Sept. 1839 aged 50 yrs. da. Catherine aged 28 yrs.
26. Innes Stewart slate quarrier Ballachulish who d. 18 Nov. 1844 aged 64 yrs. and of his sons James d. 30 Dec. 1846 aged 28 and John 23 June 1849 aged 43 yrs.
27. Betty Stewart who d. 16 Mar. 1819 aged 50 yrs. By her husband Alex. McKensie slate quarrier at Larooh.
- 27a. John Cameron d. 1868? and Ann Cameron his spouse who departed 9 May 1811 aged 74 yrs.
- 27b. John Stewart who d at West Larooh 19 Jun. 1841 aged 68 yrs. and

28. Duncan McIntyre who d. at East Larooh on 26 Oct. 1883 aged 68 yrs. Christine Rankin his wife d. 20 Feb. 1884 aged 69 yrs. and of their family Catherine d. 6 Oct. 1849 aged 6 yrs. Alexander d. 6 Nov. 1883 aged 28 yrs. Donald who d. 20 Feb. 1893 aged 44. Catherine d. 2 Sept. 1893 aged 42 yrs. Erected by D. and J. McIntyre.
29. By Mary MacDonald in Loving memory of husband John Henderson who d. at Glencoe 13 Nov.
30. Sacred to memory of Dum(can) McKenzie late tenant at North Ballachulish and of his spouse Ann Stewart, by their Grandson Dum. McKenzie, smith at Larooh. (There is an interesting picture here of Highlander on foot fighting) "The fate of an English Aragoon who attacked D. McK. at the battle of Prest. P (Preston Pans) where he fought under Prince Charles Stuart".
31. Neil Rankin a native of Fort William late master of the Lady Ann who departed this life at Coltry near Fort Augustus on the 24 Aug. 1831 aged 55 yrs. By his children. (1835).
- * 32. John McInnes who died in North Ballachulish 19 May 1853 aged 45 yrs. also his three sons Ewen, Donald and John who d. in inf. Erected by his wife and only son Samuel.
33. By John MacIntyre late tenant at Brecklet in memory of his spouse Clemy MacNab who departed this life the 14 Sept. 1808 aged 43 yrs.
34. Robert MacIntyre b. at Brecklet Glencoe 1803 d. at Lichintuin 12 Nov. 1869 also of his wife Christina McColl^l at Invernahyle Appin 21 Oct. 1810 d. at Kiel House, Duror 29 Nov. 1882 erected by their son John MacIntyre, Kiel House, Duror. Within this enclosure are also interred John MacIntyre who d. at Achnacone 12 Nov. 1838 aged 80 yrs. and his wife Clemintina McNab who d. at Brecklet 14 Sept. 1808 aged 43 yrs.
35. 1840. Erected by the Rev. John MacMillan M.A. of the Episcopal Church to the memory of his brother Donald MacMillan who d. at Larooh 9 Jul. 1824 aged 24 yrs.
36. By Angus McIntyre, merchant at Carnoch Glencoe in memory of his father, John McIntyre who d. in Aug. 180 (last figure covered by another stone) aged 63 yrs.
37. Here lies along with his forefathers and two of his sons the remains of Donald McKenzie late tenant at Ounich who d. 9 May 1817 aged 61 yrs. By his son Duncan McKenzie, Mariner, Fort William.
38. Ann McKenzie who departed this life on 1 Mar. 1849 aged 82 yrs. Erected by her loving son Ewan Cameron also to the memory of his da. Ann who d. on 27 Oct. 1849 2 yrs.
- * 39. John McKenzie late of Onich who d. there 9 Feb. 1871 aged 82 yrs. Ann McInnes his wife who d. 27 Jul. 1873 aged 75 yrs. and also of their children Donald d. 9 Aug. 1845 aged 23 Peter 18 Oct. 1865 aged 30 Ann d. 5 Feb. 1878 aged 46 Mary who d. 14 Dec. 1893 aged 63. This stone was erected by Mary last survivor of the family.

40. Angus Nicolson North Ballachulish who d. 9 Jun. 1847 aged 70 yrs. and spouse Flora Cameron who d. 27 Jun. 1833 aged 45 yrs. and also of their children Alex, Duncan, Colin and Effy. By their da. Sarah 1855.
41. Duncan Cameron descendant of the ancient family of Callart for many years chief clarke to the slate quarries of Balachulish who having passed through this life esteemed and respected d. at Laroch 13 Dec. 1828 aged 42 yrs. his employers have caused this stone to be placed over his mortal remains in testimony of their regret for the loss of an intelligent an honest and a zealous servant.
42. 1815. Here lyes the remains of John McKenzie and Catharine McKenzie his spouse. Erected by Hugh McKenzie, smith, Laroch in memory of his son John who d. 11 Dec. 1813.

45. Ewen Cameron late schoolmaster, Glenroeran who d. at Ellerig on the 12 Nov. 1895 aged 65 yrs. also in memory of his father and mother buried here.

Donald McInnes late quarrier at Laroch who d. 6 Aug. 1824 aged 55 yrs. and his spouse Christina Cameron who d. 22 Jun. 1825 aged 49 yrs. and of their children John Alexander, Alexander, Mary and Christina who d. in their infancies. By their sons Donald Archibald and Angus McInnes at Larach 1831.
47. John McInnes late quarrier in Laroch who d. 11 Nov. 1834 aged 29 yrs. By his father Paul McInnes, Slate quarrier Laroch and Mary Stewart his wife A.D. 1838.

49. John Cameron who d. at Inchrie 7 Jul. 1833 aged 63 yrs. and his spouse Catherine Cameron d. 4 May 1852 aged 84 yrs.
50. Marey McKenzie spouse of John Cameron Schoolmaster at Laroch who d. 16 Mar. 1806 aged 60 yrs.
51. Duncan McKenzie farmer, for sometime residing at North Ballachulish and afterwards at Kenbeachie, Ross-shire where he died Jan 7 1854 aged 78 yrs. and Sarah Kennedy his wife who d. at Kinbeachie aged 74 yrs. on May 30 1857.
52. By John McKenzie overseer Ballachulish Slate Work in memory of his beloved wife Catherine Kennedy who died on 25th Aug. 1848 aged 62 yrs. and his son John who d. 12 Apr. 1848 aged 27 yrs.

58. By John Rankin merchant Fort William in memory of his father Ewen Rankin who d. at Achintoure Apr. 2 1850 aged 95 yrs.
59. In memory of John McIntyre late tacksman of Achnacon, Glencoe who d. 12 Nov. 1838 aged 80 yrs. erected by his son Robert McIntyre tacksman of Achnacon 1845.
60. Alexander McDonald from Clachaich late tennant at Laggan Glengerry who d. 16 Nov. 1801 aged 63 yrs. and his spouse Mary McDonald. By Order of their sons Angus and Ranold McDonald.
61. Donald McInnes late tennant of Achindarroch who d. 1816 aged 63 and of Catharine McColl his spouse who d. this year 1811 aged 56 yrs By their sons Hugh and Duncan McInnes.
62. Kenneth McInnes late in Laroch who d. 13 Nov. 1793 aged 70 yrs.
63. Donald Robertson and his deceased family. Hewas formerly in the 76th Reg., was wounded in Holland and afterwards of Gorsten eorna, Balachulish, d. 1809 aged 54 yrs. Mary McColl his first wife d. 1804. and was interred in Glencorran cemetery. Hugh was drowned 1817 aged 15; Maloom d. in Canada about 1818 aged 22, Mary d. 1827 aged 33, Allan d. 1849 aged 41, Julia Fletcher the second wife d. 1853 aged 78, James d. at Melbourne 1870 aged 67 yrs. 65. Erected by Malcolm McColl to the memory of his wife Flora McInnes and their 5 children 1847.

66. of Angus McInnes who d. 28 Jul. 1839 aged 19 yrs. By his father John McInnes, Leadgreenoch, Appin and Sarah McColl his wife.
67. Donald McMaster late tennant of Inverighan who d. 1 Jan. 1830 aged 73 yrs. By his da. Jean 1837. Mary MacMaster or Cameron aged 78 yrs. d. in 1883 Jane McMaster late tenant of Inohaig d. 30 Oct. 1895.
68. John Stewart who departed this life 26 Oct. 1817 aged 18 yrs. By parents John Stewart and Jean McDonghid, : Slate Quarry.

He was the eldest son of the Chief and was succeeded by his own eldest son Alex. who was attainted of high treason for joining the rising of 1715 and who was father of John MacDonald of Glencoe whose concern in the rising of 1745 led to the house being burned down and whose only son was Alexander MacDonald, of Glencoe O.B. 1814.
73. To ... of John MacLean late quarrier at Laroch who departed this life on the 15 Sept. 1820 aged 58 yrs. to his son Alexander who departed this life on 13 May 1821 aged 16 yrs. 81. In memory of Alexander McKenzie merchant Brecklet who was b. at Kilmorag on the 25 Dec. 1815 who d. at Brecklet on the 29 Apr. 1875 He was honest in business much respected by all who knew him.
